<b>DIVISIONS/SECTORS</b>	Fireground 1 to 8 Fireground Repeater 1 to 4 Field Ops Channels (located in PMR radios)
<b>AIR OPERATIONS</b>	eG027 HAWK (located in PMR radios)
<b>STRIKE TEAMS</b>	Fireground 4
<b>INTER AGENCY LIAISON</b>	ESO Channels (located in PMR radios)
<b>TRAINING</b>	Fireground 1 to 8 Field Ops Channels (located in PMR radios)
